The Blackshear Presidential Fellowship, named after esteemed Bankruptcy Judge Cornelius Blackshear, provides both waived conference registration and a stipend for reasonable travel/hotel expenses for up to five up-and coming minority bankruptcy practitioners (with two to ten years of experience) who wish to attend the annual meeting of the National Conference of Bankruptcy Judges and who otherwise meets the selection criteria.
